Preparation for Worship

As you enter the Sanctuary, please prepare your heart for worship and silence your mobile devices.

What truly matters at church is what matters to God, and what matters to God is the continual gathering of new people into His flock. The entire Bible traces the journey from the original creation to new creation, from humanity's great rebellion against the Creator to God's even greater provision of redemption in the person and work of the Lord Jesus Christ. The story of the Bible is therefore the story of God's mission to bring sinful humanity back into communion with Himself!

However, an important question we must ask for those whom God has called into a saving, covenant relationship with Himself is, "what now?" Are we meant to sit on the sidelines and wait for Jesus to finish His mission? To that question, the Bible answers with a resounding "no!" God in His wisdom and grace chooses to dignify His people by calling them into His mission.

As we have seen in the book of Acts, after Jesus ascended, God gave the Spirit to all believers so that they may serve as His witnesses. In Ephesians, Paul says we have been saved for the good works of the Kingdom (Eph. 2:8-10). He told the Corinthians that as new creations, we have been given the ministry of reconciliation, tasked with bringing the Kingdom of God and its ethic of love to bear in this world (2 Cor. 5: 16-21). There is no greater purpose that could be given than the call the Church has received to be laborers for the Lord's harvest.

Let us now joyfully worship the Lord who has made us a part of His flock and calls us to labor with Him in His mission of redemption!


