For Holy Week, the pulpit fall is a deep red, silk damask signifying the blood of Christ upon which is embroidered a black Latin Cross stitched in black silk edged in gold, bearing a crown of green thorns signifying life and that “though He die, yet shall He live.” The Bible markers display the same green crown of thorns.

LUNCH IS SERVED FROM 11:00-11:45 A.M. AND AGAIN FROM 12:30-1:15 P.M. IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL.

### Option 1: Salad Bar (\$7)
