Preparation for Worship

As you enter the Sanctuary, please prepare your heart for worship and silence your mobile devices.

As you prepare your heart to worship God, let us think for a moment why we prioritize corporate worship.

- Corporate worship provides us an opportunity to demonstrate where
 our true allegiance lies. Williams Barclay offers this challenge: "Even
 if the sermon be poor and the worship gaudy and showy, faithful
 attendance of corporate worship still gives us the chance to show the
 world what side we are on."
- Corporate worship strengthens our faith in the promises of God. In
 worship, we sing God's promises in our hymns, we rehearse God's
 promises in our prayers, and we listen to God's promises in His Word
 read and preached. We see His promises dramatized in His sacraments.
 It is difficult to experience the full assurance of faith or the sturdy
 confidence of hope without the weekly rhythm of corporate worship.
- Corporate worship offers us opportunities for ministering to fellow believers. John Chrysostom describes how it works: "As iron sharpens iron so also fellowship increases love. For if a stone rubbed against a stone sends forth fire, how much more a person in contact with a person. It doesn't have to be a fire that consumes and destroys, but it can be a fire that warms and heats your love and devotion to Jesus."
