## Preparation for Worship

As you enter the Sanctuary, please prepare your heart for worship and silence your mobile devices.

There are many ways to highlight what the work of Jesus Christ accomplishes on our behalf. For example, it accomplishes reconciliation, atonement, propitiation, redemption, and justification. The one upon which we reflect today is redemption. Redemption is a word that "describes a marketplace transaction with reference to the purchase of goods or the releasing of slaves" (*Baker's Evangelical Dictionary of Theology*).

Our sermon text teaches us that we are delivered from the bondage of sin and the devil's dark kingdom by the payment of a ransom price. That price was Jesus' perfect life of obedience to the Father as well as His substitutionary death on the cross. Simply put, He lived the life we should have lived and He died the death we should have died.

Let us prepare to worship our Redeemer King who paid fully for our sins. Would you pray and ask the Lord to dissolve any residual hardness in your heart; to ignite in you a glad heart of thanksgiving and full devotion; and to galvanize you to cease making other people pay for the ways that they fail you?
