PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

As you enter the Sanctuary, please prepare your heart for worship and silence your mobile devices.

Every church uses some type of liturgy when they gather for corporate worship. For some, liturgy connotes a lifeless, mindless, repetitive worship service. However, for us, liturgy refers to a prescribed pattern for public worship. Our "liturgical" service seeks to highlight at every point the stunning beauty and grandeur of the gospel of our Lord.

The word "liturgy" comes from a word in Greek that means "public service." For example, Luke states in his Gospel that Zechariah's time of "service was ended" (Luke 1:23). The word for service is the word "liturgy."

Therefore, "liturgy" reminds us that worship is the priestly service of the church. By the power of the Holy Spirit and out of gratitude to Almighty God, we humble ourselves before Him by declaring His worth, confessing His lordship over us, and rendering to Him honor and glory, according to His Word.

What a tremendous privilege we have to serve as our Lord's worshippers. May our worship today cause us to know and delight in Jesus Christ more fully as our sure foundation, our steadfast Savior, and our solid anchor!

Jesus Christ our faithful Savior. Amen.


