On May 10th Angela broke her hip and had emergency surgery. This came very unexpectedly for us and is unusual for her (young) age! Apparently she had developed a stress fracture of the femoral neck, presumably due to exercise. The day after discovering this and before her followup with the orthopedic surgeon, she tripped using crutches, which resulted in a complete displaced fracture of the femoral neck. She will have a 3-4 month recovery, starting with 6 weeks of no weight bearing on her left leg. **Please pray for complete healing of the bone! Pray also for her patience and stamina during the recovery process.** We have been planning to return to Kenya in August and are unsure if this will delay our return. **Please pray for wisdom as we consider the timing of our return.**
