Task: Cleaning # of People Needed: 5-7 People When: 2:30-3:30 PM on Sunday.

JOB: Volunteers will arrive at the St. Matthews UMC (1362 South Prescott) to prepare for incoming groups. Tasks include sweeping dormitories, cleaning bathrooms, changing trash, sweeping and mopping cafeteria, and other cleaning jobs. Check with the Volunteer Coordinator, Rebecca Tarleton, to find out what needs to be cleaned and where supplies are located. She can meet volunteers at the church at 2:30.

IMPORTANCE: During this time our staff is in meetings to prepare for the upcoming week. If volunteers don't do these tasks, then our staff has to cut into their prep time in order to accomplish them.

Task: Kitchen Duty # of People Needed: 4-5 People (No children under 12 please) When: 5:30-7:15 PM Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

JOB: Volunteers arrive at St. Matthews UMC (1362 South Prescott) to help serve dinner and clean up. Meet with Volunteer Coordinator, Rebecca Tarleton, and the Kitchen Manager, Ethan Cagle. Volunteers will help set tables; serve meals to the tables; they will supervise the dining area; following dinner, volunteers will wash dishes, sweep cafeteria, and clean the kitchen, along with other clean-up jobs. Volunteers are welcome to stay for evening chapel. Friday we will need volunteers to help with the grill!

JOB: Volunteers will arrive at St. Matthews UMC (1362 South Prescott) to help cater and serve lunch for SOS staff. SOS staff eats lunch together on Wednesdays from 1 - 2:30 p.m. Volunteers may cook or cater lunch for our staff. Please plan to feed 75 hungry adults. Please arrive early enough to set up, and plan on staying to clean up.
