Ministry Description for Director of Ministries for Women Second Presbyterian Church

- I. **Purpose:** To lead, teach, and nurture the women of the church as they endeavor to walk with Christ.
- II. Relationships: Reports to the Pastoral Division
 Works closely with the Pastoral Staff
 Coordinates with all staff
 Oversees Ministries and Programs for women

III. Responsibilities:

A. Spiritual Leadership

- 1. To grow in the knowledge of Christ and in the gospel through the faithful use of the means of grace;
- 2. To set a godly example for women;
- 3. To embrace and actively promote every aspect of the 2PC mission, and to integrate the ministries for women with all 2PC ministries.

B. Leadership for Women

- 1. To lead women in prayer and thoughtful Bible study as they are prompted to deepen their relationships with Christ;
- 2. To evangelize, teach, train and disciple women in such a way as they may, in turn, reach others with the gospel;
- 3. To provide mature and wise counsel to women in need;
- 4. To resource, coordinate, and encourage all ministries for women at 2PC and to develop an annual ministry plan with a commensurate budget;
- 5. To coordinate successfully with all 2PC ministries and to facilitate the effective participation of women in 2PC ministries;
- 6. To hire, train, encourage, and manage the departmental staff associated with ministries for women at 2PC;
- 7. To recruit, train and oversee leadership teams for women and to work with and through those teams to oversee ministries for women;
- 8. To oversee the process of ministry evaluation and strategic planning;
- 9. To advocate for and respond to the concerns of women at 2PC.

C. Community Leadership

- 1. To lead in the desire of the church to proclaim the gospel by caring for the needs of others through its ministries for women in Memphis and the surrounding Mid-south communities;
- 2. To represent 2PC women in the Memphis community, in the denomination, and in the world.
